TODAY'S MESSAGE: *The Crown of Thorns*

TEXT MESSAGE: *Matthew 27:27-32*

The soldiers platted a crown of thorns and placed it upon the head of Jesus. Was this just a footnote in the crucifixion story? Or does it have meaning for us today? Think with me about:

1) **The Material of the Crown.**

Genesis 3:18.

Thorns are symbols of the judgment of God upon the sin of mankind. Those thorns were placed upon the head of the only sinless man who ever lived.

2) **The Making of the Crown.**

Isaiah 53:6

The entire band of soldiers made the Crown. Our sins platted that crown and placed it upon Christ's head.

3) **The Misery and the Mockery of the Crown.**

Isaiah 52:14; 53:3.

The soldiers beat Jesus with canes, struck him and pulled out his beard. His face was so disfigured, he was unrecognizable. They mocked him and spit in his face. Yet he opened not His mouth.

Isaiah 53:7-8.

4) **The Message of the Crown.**

Genesis 22:1-14; Galatians 3:13.

Jesus bore the curse of our sins on the Cross. The gory crown has become a crown of glory for those who receive Christ as Lord.

Philippians 2:5-11; Revelation 19:11-16.
